Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 13th February 1976
Coming into operation 2nd March 1976

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), and now vested in it(b), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Laundry Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976.

Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 2nd day of March 1976, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

The Laundry Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 (Order N.I.L. (75)) shall have effect as if in the Schedule thereto there was inserted, after paragraph 2, the following paragraph:—

Paragraph 2A.

"ATTACK ON INFLATION" SUPPLEMENT

In addition to the remuneration paid under paragraphs 1 or 2 there shall be paid a supplement entitled "Attack on Inflation" Supplement as follows:—

All workers 19 years of age and over	9·125

18 and under 19 years	7.625
17 " " 18 "	6-50
16 " " 17 "	6.00

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 2nd March 1976 amends the Laundry Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 (Order N.I.L. (75)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by that Order.

New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.
