**The Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 4)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1976**

Made 20th February 1976

Coming into operation 20th February 1976

WHEREAS by Article 1(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), it is provided that the Order shall come into force on such day or days as the Secretary of State may by order appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:

1. The day appointed for the coming into operation—
 - (a) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 shall be 5th April 1976; and
 - (b) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 shall be 6th April 1978.
2. This order may be cited as the Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This order appoints the dates for the coming into force of all those provisions of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 which are not already in operation, except Article 24 and certain related provisions in Schedule 5, which relate to mobility allowance and are already in operation for certain purposes only, Article 59 and Schedule 3, which relate to the preservation requirements, and certain other provisions in Schedule 6.
