Licence Holders' (Records and Returns) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1976*Made* 24th February 1976*Coming into operation* 1st April 1976

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licence Holders' (Records and Returns) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1976.

2. There shall be substituted for the First Schedule of the Licence Holders' (Records and Returns) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1972(c) the following Schedule:

"FIRST SCHEDULE

Licence for a fixed tidal draft net.

Licence for a fixed tidal draft net which operates in the estuary of a river upstream of the defined mouth.

Licence for a tidal draft net.

Licence for a drift net used in tidal waters.

Licence for a bag net used in tidal waters.

Licence for a salmon box or crib."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations revise the list of commercial fishing licences the holders of which are required to make returns to the Department of Agriculture of their catches of salmon, sea trout and trout. The holders of licences for draft nets for the capture of salmon and freshwater fish on Lough Neagh, for draft nets for use in freshwater other than Lough Neagh or Lough Erne, and for single wall set nets or trammel nets for the capture of trout in Lough Neagh are no longer required to make returns to the Department.
