To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State(a) in pursuance of section 21(3)(a) and (f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b), after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Petty Sessions District (Castlewellan) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 17th October 1977.

Place for holding Castlewellan Petty Sessions

2. Petty Sessions for the petty sessions district of Castlewellan shall be held at Newcastle, a place outside the petty sessions district of Castlewellan, but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said district and at the times specified in the Petty Sessions Times Order (Northern Ireland) 1974(c).
