Employment in Agriculture (Amendment) (No. 2) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 31st August 1977. . 10th October 1977 Coming into operation . .

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a) as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(b) and now vested in it(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department(c) of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Citation and commencement

1.--(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Employment in Agriculture (Amendment) (No. 2) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall be included among the Schemes which may together be cited as the Employment in Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Schemes 1972-1977.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on 10th October 1977.

Amendment of Scheme

2. In article 5(3) of the Employment in Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Scheme 1972(d) for "£40,000,000" there shall be substituted "£65,000,000".
