WELFARE FOODS

Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 17th October 1977

Coming into operation 14th November 1977

The Department(a) of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(3) of the Welfare Foods Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 14th November 1977.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations the expression "the principal regulations" means the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977(c) as amended by the Welfare Foods (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977(d) and other words and expressions have the same meaning as in the principal regulations.

Amendment of the principal regulations

3. In Schedule 1 (Entitlement to welfare food other than welfare milk) to the principal regulations in column (3):—

(a) for "8p" there shall be substituted "9p", and

(b) for "10p" in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted "17p".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977, as amended by the Welfare Foods (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977, by increasing the prices at which Children's Vitamin Drops and Vitamin Tablets¹ for expectant and nursing mothers may be bought as follows:—

- (i) Children's Vitamin Drops: from 8p to 9p per bottle.
- (ii) Mother's Vitamin Tablets: from 10p to 17p per container.
