MAGISTRATES' COURTS

Magistrates' Courts (Amendment No. 2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 21st October 1977

Coming into operation 1st December 1977

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State^(a) in pursuance of section 23 of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964^(b), on the recommendation of the Magistrates' Courts Rules Committee and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts (Amendment No. 2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1977.

Amendment of the 1974 rules

2.—(1) In rule 13 of the Magistrates' Courts Rules (Northern Ireland) 1974^(c) after paragraph (2) there shall be added the following paragraph:

“(3) In this rule a reference to a summons includes a document related thereto.”

(2) In schedule 3 to those rules after paragraph 2 there shall be added the following paragraph:

“(3) Where a document relating to a summons is served together with the summons there shall be payable a fee of £1.00 for each document served.”

These rules amend the Magistrates' Courts Rules (Northern Ireland) 1974 to provide for the payment of a fee to a summons server for service of a document where the document is served together with a summons.
