COUNTY COURTS**County Court (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1977***Made* 8th November 1977*Coming into operation* 5th December 1977*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State^(a) in pursuance of section 146 of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959^(b), on the recommendation of the County Court Rules Committee and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the County Court (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 5th December 1977.

Increase in interest rate on amount awarded by decree

2.—(1) In Order 30 of the County Court Rules (Northern Ireland) 1976^(c) in rule 2 for the words “seven pounds per centum” there shall be substituted the words “ten pounds per centum”.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to a decree made before the coming into operation of these rules.
