Companies (Payment of Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977*Made* 14th February 1977*Coming into operation* 1st April 1977

The Department(a) of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b) and now vested in it(c) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Companies (Payment of Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

Collection of fees

2. The fees payable in the office of the Registrar of Companies under the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960(d) shall be collected in money.

Revocation

3. The Regulations relating to fees payable to the Registrar of Companies made by the Ministry of Finance dated 5th January 1933(e) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order provides that fees in the Companies Registry, hitherto payable by means of stamps, shall, from 1st April 1977, be payable in money.
