**Family Law Reform (1977 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1977**

Made 24th November 1977
Coming into operation 1st January 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 1(2) of the Family Law Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a) I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Family Law Reform (1977 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1978.

Appointed day

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of Part II and Part IV of the Family Law Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 shall be 1st January 1978.
