MAGISTRATES' COURTS**Petty Sessions District (Pomeroy) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977***Made* 6th December 1977*Coming into operation* 1st February 1978*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State(a) in pursuance of section 21(3) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b), after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Petty Sessions District (Pomeroy) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1978.

Abolition of Pomeroy Petty Sessions District

2. The Petty Sessions District of Pomeroy shall be added to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Cookstown and, accordingly, the Petty Sessions District of Pomeroy is hereby abolished.

Revocations

3. The Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(c) and so much of the Petty Sessions Times Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(d) as relates to the Petty Sessions District of Pomeroy are hereby revoked.
