WAGES COUNCILS

Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 18th March 1977

Coming into operation 29th March 1977

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), and now vested in it(b), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Laundry Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977.

Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression “the specified date” means 29th March 1977, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression “the specified date” means as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

SCHEDULE

Statutory Minimum Remuneration

The Laundry Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974(c) (Order N.I.L. (75)) as amended by the Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(d) (Order N.I.L. (78)) shall have effect as if in the Schedule thereto for paragraph 2A there was substituted the following paragraph:—

Paragraph 2A:

"ATTACK ON INFLATION" SUPPLEMENT

In addition to the remuneration paid under paragraph 1 or 2 there shall be paid a supplement entitled "Attack on Inflation" Supplement as follows:—

	<i>Per hour up to and including a maximum of 40 hours per week</i>
<i>All workers 19 years of age and over</i>	<i>p</i> <i>15.375</i>
JUVENILE WORKERS	
<i>18 and under 19 years</i>	<i>12.85</i>
<i>17 and under 18 years</i>	<i>10.95</i>
<i>16 and under 17 years</i>	<i>10.125</i>

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 29th March 1977, amends the Laundry Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 (Order N.I.L. (75)) as amended by the Laundry Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 (Order N.I.L. (78)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by those Orders.

Order N.I.L. (78) is revoked.

New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.
