SOCIAL SECURITY**The Social Security (Contributions) (Consequential Amendments) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977**

Made 29th December 1977

Coming into operation 6th April 1978

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3 of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) (Consequential Amendments) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1978.

Amendment of regulation 3 of the Social Security (Contributions) (Consequential Amendments) Regulations

2. In regulation 3 of the Social Security (Contributions) (Consequential Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(b), as amended(c), (insertion of new regulation 5A in the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(d)) for "£11·50 and £81·00" there shall be substituted "£17·50 and £120·00".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations further amend the Social Security (Contributions) (Consequential Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 by substituting new lower and upper earnings limits (£17.50 and £120.00 respectively) for Class 1 contributions for the tax year beginning 6th April 1978.
