Drift Net Dimensions Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 3rd February 1977

Coming into operation 2nd May 1977

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland, in exercise of its powers under section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(b) of Agriculture hereby makes the following Byelaws:

Citation and commencement

1. These Byelaws may be cited as the Drift Net Dimensions Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 1977.

Dimensions of drift nets

2. After Bye-law 42 of the Fisheries Consolidated, Amendment and Licence Duties Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1969(c) there shall be added the following Bye-laws:

“42(A) No person shall use for the capture of salmon in tidal waters any drift net containing more than 45 full meshes measured vertically between the top rope and the bottom rope of the net;

42(B) no person shall have on board any vessel used for drift net fishing for salmon in tidal waters:

- (a) Any drift net of greater length than 1,500 yards;
- (b) Any number of drift nets joined together in such a way that their total length is greater than 1,500 yards;
- (c) Any number of drift nets which, if they were joined together, would have a total length greater than 1,500 yards;
- (d) Any drift net containing more than 45 full meshes measured vertically between the top rope and the bottom rope of the net.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Byelaws but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Byelaws amend the Fisheries Consolidated, Amendment and Licence Duties Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1969.

They control the length and depth of drift nets which may be on board any vessel used for drift net fishing for salmon or may be used for drift net fishing for salmon. Drift nets longer than 1,500 yards or containing more than 45 full meshes measured vertically between the top rope and the bottom rope are prohibited.

Under section 26(5) of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 a contravention of these Byelaws constitutes an offence penalties for which are provided for by section 201 of that Act.
