**Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules
(Northern Ireland) 1978**

Made : 28th June 1978

Coming into operation 14th August 1978

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State in pursuance of section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) and after consultation with the Minister for the Civil Service(c) hereby makes the following rules :

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 14th August 1978 and shall have effect as from 1st September 1977.

Maximum fee payable for assisting at post-mortem examinations

2. Rule 7 of the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(d) shall be amended by substituting the amount "£2.47" for the amount "£2.25".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the rules but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These rules provide for an increase in the maximum fee payable to persons assisting at post-mortem examinations.

The rules have retrospective effect as from 1st September 1977 by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
