## ANIMALS

Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme (Amendment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1978

Made . . . . . 10th August 1978

Coming into operation . . . . . 15th September 1978

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3B of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) (as added by section 2 of the Diseases of Animals (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(c)) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, having consulted with the bodies which appeared to it to be substantially representative of the interests concerned, and with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 15th September 1978.

*Amendment of the Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1976*

2. The Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1976 as contained in the Schedule to the Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(d) is hereby amended as follows:

(1) In article 1 in the definition of "treatment period" for "15th September" there shall be substituted "2nd October";

(2) After article 3 there shall be added:

*"Restriction on sale*

3A. During the notification period no person shall, either privately or otherwise, sell or expose for sale or permit the sale or exposure for sale of any animal bearing visible evidence of being diseased and not accompanied by a current certificate of treatment.;

(3) In article 8 after "the owner shall receive" there shall be inserted "on request";

(4) In article 9 for paragraph (1)(c) there shall be substituted:

"(c) it is being moved direct to an abattoir or to a market where animals are being sold for the purpose of immediate slaughter.;"

(5) In article 10 for the words from "in respect of" to "issued" there shall be substituted "exempted from treatment";

(6) In article 11 after "human consumption" there shall be added "unless the owner is otherwise directed by the Department.;"

(7) In article 12(1) for the second sentence there shall be substituted:

“The Department shall compensate the owner of any animal which aborts, dies or becomes ill within 7 days after treatment or subsequently dies as a result of such illness where the Department is satisfied that the cause was directly or indirectly attributable to the treatment and that the owner took all reasonable steps within 7 days after treatment to have the animal examined and given remedial attention by a veterinary surgeon.”;

(8) In the Schedule for Form B there shall be substituted:

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This order adds further amendments to the Warble Fly (Treatment) Scheme Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 as follows:—

(a) the commencing date of the treatment period for autumn treatment of animals is changed from 15th September to 2nd October;

(b) it will be an offence to expose for sale or permit the sale of visibly warbled animals which are not accompanied by a certificate of treatment;

(c) the Department will now issue treatment and exemption certificates only if the owner requires them and makes a request for them;

(d) animals may be moved from a restricted herd during the treatment period if they are going to a market to be sold for the purpose of immediate slaughter;

(e) the prohibition on the sale of animals for slaughter for 21 days after treatment will be subject to direction by the Department;

(f) the Department shall compensate the owner of an animal which has fallen ill within 7 days after treatment by the Department and which subsequently dies if the owner has had the animal examined and tended by a veterinary surgeon within the 7 days.

**Medicines (Advertising to Medical and Dental Practitioners)  
Regulations 1978**

These Regulations have been made by the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 95, 129(5) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act this Order has been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules Act (Northern Ireland) 1958. It is printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1978 and has been numbered 1020 in that series.
