Marketing of Potatoes (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978

Made 16th August 1978

Coming into operation 1st October 1978

The Department(a) of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 3(3), 7(2) and 11 of the Marketing of Potatoes Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Marketing of Potatoes (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1978.

Amendment of the Marketing of Potatoes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964

2. In paragraphs (1), (3) and (4) of Regulation 8 of the Marketing of Potatoes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964(c) for "55p" there shall be substituted "70p".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Marketing of Potatoes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964.

They increase the fee payable for the inspection of potatoes from 55p per tonne to 70p per tonne.
