**INDUSTRIAL TRAINING****Industrial Training (Grants and Loans) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978**

*Made* . . . . . 1st February 1978

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st April 1978

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of  
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department(a) of Manpower Services, in exercise of powers conferred by section 5(3) of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) and now vested in it(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the consent of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Training (Grants and Loans) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1978.

*Increase in aggregate of grants and loans*

2. The Department of Manpower Services hereby determines that the permitted maximum of the aggregate of the grants and loans made under section 5(1) of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 shall be increased from ten million pounds(d) to fifteen million pounds.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order increases from £10,000,000 (the figure determined by the Department of Manpower Services for Northern Ireland under Article 2 of the Industrial Training (Grants and Loans) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976) to £15,000,000 the aggregate of the grants and loans that may be made by the Department to industrial training boards.
