The Industrial Relations (1976 No. 2 Order) (Commencement No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1 of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(a) and paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Relations (1976 No. 2 Order) (Commencement No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1979.

Appointed day

- 2. The following provisions of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 shall come into operation on 1st January 1979:
 - (a) In Article 39(3)(b) the words "or Articles 37 and 38" (time off for trade union duties and activities);
 - (b) Articles 40 (provisions as to industrial tribunals) and 42 (provisions supplementary to Articles 37 to 41) so far as they relate to Articles 37 and 38;
 - (c) Article 43(2)(c) (priority of certain debts on insolvency) so far as it relates to any payment under Article 37(4).

EXPLANATORY NOTE
