*Citation*

1. These rules may be cited as the County Court (Blood Tests) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1979.

*Amendment of the Rules of 1978*

2. For any reference in the County Court (Blood Tests) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1978(b) to the clerk of the Crown and peace there shall be substituted a reference to the chief clerk.
