**Chaff-Cutting Machines (Accidents) Act 1897 (Repeal) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1979**

Made 11th April 1979

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(6) of the Agriculture (Safety, Health and Welfare Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(b), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Chaff-Cutting Machines (Accidents) Act 1897 (Repeal) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979.

Appointed Day

2. The day appointed for the repeal of the Chaff-Cutting Machines (Accidents) Act 1897(c) as respects Northern Ireland shall be 1st May 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order appoints 1st May 1979 as the day on which, as respects Northern Ireland, the Chaff-Cutting Machines (Accidents) Act 1897 shall be repealed. The Agriculture (Stationary Machinery) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1966 No. 166 (p. 538) contained provisions replacing those of that Act.
