COMPANIES**Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979***Made* 18th June 1979*Coming into operation* 31st July 1979*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 373(1)(a)(a) of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1979.

Fees

2. The fees specified in the second column of the Schedule shall be payable to the registrar of companies in respect of the matters mentioned in the first column of the Schedule.

Fees to be paid to the Registrar of Companies

For re-registration of a company under the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960 in pursuance of Article 118 of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(c)	£5
For re-registration of a company under the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960 in pursuance of Article 119 of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1978	£50

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations require specified fees to be paid to the registrar of companies on the re-registration of a company as unlimited or limited.
