**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES****One-Way Traffic (Larne) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979**

Made . . . . . 4th October 1979

Coming into operation . . . . . 12th November 1979

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 19 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Larne) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 12th November 1979.

*Amendment*

2. The One-Way Traffic (Larne) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979(b) shall be amended by the addition to schedule 1 thereto of the following:—

<p>Pound Street, from its junction with The Harbour Highway to its junction with Meeting House Street.</p>	<p>North Easterly from the Harbour Highway.</p>

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This order amends the One-Way Traffic (Larne) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 (S.R. 1979 No. 38) by the addition to schedule 1 of Pound Street, from its junction with the Harbour Highway to its junction with Meeting House Street.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order have been erected on the roads.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.
