HEALTH AND PERSONAL SOCIAL SERVICES**The Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (1978 Act) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979***Made* 10th October 1979*Coming into operation* 31st October 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 21(2) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (1978 Act) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 31st October 1979.

Appointed day

2. The appointed day for the coming into operation of section 14 of the Act (which relates to badges for display on motor vehicles used by disabled persons) shall be 31st October 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This order appoints 31st October 1979 as the appointed day for the coming into operation of section 14 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Northern Ireland) Act 1978 which empowers the Department to prescribe a form of badges to be issued to disabled persons and to institutions for the disabled.
