The Secretary of State in pursuance of section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) and after consultation with the Minister for the Civil Service hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 17th April 1979 and shall have effect as from 1st September 1977.

Maximum fee payable for assisting at post-mortem examinations

2. Rule 7 of the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) shall be amended by substituting the amount "£2.81" for the amount "£2.47".
