WILD BIRDS

Barnacle, Brent and Canada Geese and Sale of Wild Birds for Consumption Order (Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 22nd January 1980

Coming into operation 1st March 1980

The Department of the Environment(a)

- (a) in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 5, 7 and 16 of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1931(b) as amended by the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(c) and paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(d) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf;
- (b) being satisfied that it is necessary to make provision for the conservation of bird life; and
- (c) after publishing, pursuant to the said section 16, notice of proposal to make this Order and the purport thereof and not having received any objection to the said proposal.

hereby orders and directs as follows:

Citation, commencement and duration

1. This Order may be cited as the Barnacle, Brent and Canada Geese and Sale of Wild Birds for Consumption Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall remain in force for a period of three years from 1st March 1980 unless sooner varied or revoked.

Special protection for Barnacle, Brent and Canada Geese

2. Barnacle and Brent Geese shall be classified under the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1931 as being in Category I.

3. Canada Geese shall be classified under the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1931 as being in Category II.

Prohibition of sale of birds for consumption

4. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or to have in his possession for the purpose of sale, for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere by human beings or animals, any bird other than wood-pigeon.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order:—

- (a) gives protection at all times, and not only during the close season, to Barnacle and Brent Geese and to their eggs and nests
- (b) gives protection at all times, and not only during the close season to Canada Geese, and to their eggs and nests except when it is necessary for an owner or occupier of any land to kill or take these birds for the purpose of protecting crops or property from damage;
- (c) prohibits the sale for consumption of all wild birds (including wild fowl) with the exception of wood-pigeon, but does not prevent the killing of birds at times when they are not protected. It does not refer to game birds, which are protected under the Game Laws of Northern Ireland.
