**Cysticercus Bovis (Compensation) (Revocation) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1980***Made* 30th July 1980*Coming into operation* 1st September 1980

The Department(a) of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3B(b) of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance and after consultation with the bodies which appear to it to be substantially representative of the interests concerned, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Cysticercus Bovis (Compensation) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980.

Revocations

2. The Cysticercus Bovis (Compensation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966(d), the Cysticercus Bovis (Supplementary Compensation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966(e) and the Cysticercus Bovis (Metrication) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(f) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order revokes the *Cysticercus Bovis* (Compensation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966, the *Cysticercus Bovis* (Supplementary Compensation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966 and the *Cysticercus Bovis* (Metrication) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976. Compensation will no longer be payable to owners of infested carcasses nor will a levy be collected by the Department in respect of each animal slaughtered.
