The Department(a) of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(3) of the Welfare Foods Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the consent of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Welfare Foods (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 5th January 1981.

(2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977(c).

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. In Schedule 1 (entitlement to welfare food other than welfare milk) to the principal regulations in column (3)-

(a) for "14p" there shall be substituted "16p", and

(b) for "30p" in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted "33p".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations further amend the Welfare Foods Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977, by increasing the prices at which Children's Vitamin Drops and Vitamin Tablets for expectant and nursing mothers may be bought as follows:—

(a) Children's Vitamin Drops: from 14p to 16p per bottle,

(b) Mother's Vitamin Tablets: from 30p to 33p per container.
