## Industrial Assurance (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980

The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 49(1)(a) and (b) of the Industrial Assurance (Northern Ireland) Order 1979(a) (hereinafter called "the Order") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance hereby makes the following regulations:

### Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial Assurance (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

#### Fees

2. The fees set out in the Schedule shall be payable in advance to the Department of Commerce in respect of the matters listed in the Schedule.

### Revocation

3. The Industrial Assurance (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(b) are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide for a substantial increase in the fees payable in connection with the exercise by the Industrial Assurance Commissioner of his functions under the Industrial Assurance (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 and for the inspection and the furnishing of copies or extracts of documents in his custody. The fees payable for reference of a dispute to the Commissioner and in respect of an application to him under Article 36(3) of the said Order remain unchanged.

These Regulations supersede the Industrial Assurance (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976.
