**Teachers' Superannuation (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1981**

Made 18th May 1981

Coming into operation 19th June 1981

The Department(a) of Education in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 11 and 14 of and Schedule 3 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with representatives of education and library boards and of teachers and such representatives of other persons likely to be affected by the regulations as appeared to it to be appropriate as required by Article 11(5) of the said Order, with the consent of the Department of the Civil Service(c), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Superannuation (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 19th June 1981.

Application of Regulation 48 in certain cases of premature retirement

2. In regulation 48A of the Teachers' Superannuation Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977(d), the word "his" in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Teachers' Superannuation Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977.

The amendment confirms the scope of the application of regulation 48A by defining more particularly the class of teachers whose employment can be terminated by reason of redundancy.
