The Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981

Made 1st June 1981

Coming into operation 22nd June 1981

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 22nd June 1981.
2. In this Order a fee referred to by number means the fee so numbered in the Schedule to the Supreme Court Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1980(c).
3. In the fees numbered 1, 2 and 3 respectively, for “£25.00” in column 2 there shall be substituted “£30.00”.
