Meat Inspection (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981

Made 9th July 1981

Coming into operation 17th August 1981

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14 and 20(1) of the Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation and Pig Industry) Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Meat Inspection (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 17th August 1981.

Revocation

2. The Meat Inspection (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980(c) are hereby revoked.

Fees

3. The holder of a meat shipping licence shall for the inspection of meat thereunder pay on demand in respect of the several classes of animals set out below the fees set out below for each carcase or part of a carcase inspected:

Cattle	...	£2.30
Pigs	...	15p
Sheep	...	25p
Goats	...	25p
Horses	...	£1.00
