**Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grant (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981***Made* 13th August 1981*Coming into operation* 1st October 1981

The Department(a) of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 106(1) and Article 125 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grant (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1981.

Amendment of regulations

2. In paragraph (3)(c) of Regulation 7 of the Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grant Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(d) the following words shall be deleted—

“the first of which shall not be paid until at least five per cent of the estimated cost of the work has been met by the applicants”
