Diseases of Animals (Scheduled Substances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 33(3) and 60(1) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Scheduled Substances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 25th January 1982.

Amendment of the Order of 1981

2. Paragraphs 1 to 3 of Schedule 4 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 are hereby revoked.

Revocation

3. The Diseases of Animals (Scheduled Substances — Exemption) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Schedule 4 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 specifies hormonal and arsenical substances whose administration is restricted under the terms of that Order to therapeutic purposes only.

This order deletes all androgenic, oestrogenic and progestational substances from the list in Schedule 4 and so removes restriction on their use.

Medicines (Pharmacies) (Applications for Registration and Fees) Amendment Regulations 1981

These Regulations have been made by the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 75(1) and 76(1)(2)(6) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act these Regulations have been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. They are printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1981 and have been numbered 1713 in that series.
