## Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 30 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(a) as adapted by section 38 of the Act and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, hereby makes the following regulations:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1981.

#### Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to these regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Amendment of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979

- 3. Regulation 3(1) of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(d) shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) in sub-paragraph (a), for "£174" there shall be substituted "£210";
  - (b) in sub-paragraph (b), for "£116" there shall be substituted "£140";
  - (c) in sub-paragraph (c), for "£58" there shall be substituted "£70";
  - (d) in sub-paragraph (d), for "£58" there shall be substituted "£70"; and
  - (e) in sub-paragraph (e), for "£29" there shall be substituted "£35".
