**Pigs (Carcase Classification Scheme) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1981***Made* 6th March 1981*Coming into operation* 6th April 1981

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of Article 2 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, having consulted with such persons or the representatives of such persons as is required by the said Article and with the approval of the Department of Finance as to fees hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Pigs (Carcase Classification Scheme) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1981.

Amendment of fee

2. In Article 4 of the Pigs (Carcase Classification Scheme) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980(b) for "17p" there shall be substituted "25p".

Amendment of Scheme

3. In Article 9 of the Pigs (Carcase Classification) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1980 for "paragraph" there shall be substituted "Article".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Pigs (Carcase Classification Scheme) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 by increasing the fee payable to the Department of Agriculture in respect of the marking of carcasses from 17p per pig to 25p per pig. The Order also amends the Pigs (Carcase Classification) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1980 by substituting "Article" for "paragraph" in Article 9.
