Forestry (Slieve Gullion Forest Park) Regulation
(Northern Ireland) 1981

Made 19th March 1981

Coming into operation 1st May 1981

The Department(a) of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereinafter referred to as the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 14 of the Forestry Act (Northern Ireland) 1953(b), Article 7 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the consent of the Department(a) of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulation:—

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Forestry (Slieve Gullion Forest Park) Regulation (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1981.

2. The Department hereby declares that those lands owned by it and commonly known as Slieve Gullion Forest situated in the townlands of Aghadavoyle, Aghmakane, Annaghmare, Annahaia, Ballintemple, Ballynalack, Carrickaldreen, Carrickbroad, Carrickastickan, Carrive, Cashel, Clonlum, Drumintee, Longfield, Mullaghbane, Shanroe, Shean, Sheetrim, Slieve Gullion and Tievecrom, in the Administrative District of Newry and Mourne in the County of Armagh, shall be a Forest Park to which, subject to and in accordance with such bye-laws as may be made, the public shall have access.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulation.)

Section 14 of the Forestry Act (Northern Ireland) 1953 provides that the Department, with the consent of the Department of Finance, may by Regulation declare that land owned by the Department shall be treated as a Northern Ireland Forest Park to which the public shall have access. This Regulation accordingly declares that Slieve Gullion Forest in County Armagh shall be a Forest Park within the meaning of the Act.
