Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Rules 1982

Made 1st July 1982

Coming into operation 1st September 1982

To be laid before Parliament

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE ROBERT LYND ERSKINE, BARON LOWRY, Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 (2B) and paragraph 5 of the Schedule to the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943(a) as amended by the Social Security Act 1980(b) and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do hereby make the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Rules 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1982.
2. In rule 26(2) of the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Northern Ireland) Rules 1981(c), for the words "Lord Chief Justice" there shall be substituted the words "Lord Chancellor".
