Maintenance Allowances (Pupils over Compulsory School Age) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982

Made 22nd September 1982 Coming into operation 25th October 1982

The Department(a) of Education in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 39(1)(b) and (2)(b) and Article 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Maintenance Allowances (Pupils over Compulsory School Age) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 25th October 1982 and shall have effect on and from 1st September 1982.

Revocation

2. The Maintenance Allowances (Pupils over Compulsory School Age) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(d) are hereby revoked.

Amendments

- 3. The Maintenance Allowances (Pupils over Compulsory School Age) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(e) shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) For paragraph 1 of the Schedule there shall be substituted:
 - "1. The amount of a maintenance allowance shall be determined in accordance with the following table:

- (b) In paragraph 2 of the Schedule-
 - (i) for £385 there shall be substituted £400;
 - (ii) for £575 (in both places where it occurs) there shall be substituted £600;
 - (iii) for £625 (in both places where it occurs) there shall be substituted £650.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations replace, with amendments, the Maintenance Allowances (Pupils over Compulsory School Age) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981. They have retrospective effect, by virtue of Article 39(2), as substituted by Article 6(1) of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 1978, of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, on and after 1st September 1982.

The Regulations increase by 4% approximately the rates of allowances in respect of pupils over compulsory school age attending full-time courses at grant-aided schools or institutions of further education. They also similarly increase the amounts which are deductible from gross parental income in respect of other dependants to determine the balance of parental income in relation to which allowances are calculated. The Regulations increase the scales of such income by 9% approximately.
