**Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions
(Amendment) Regulations 1982**

Made 27th September 1982

Coming into operation 15th November 1982

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and, in accordance with section 2(3) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom, hereby, with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1982 and shall have effect from 1st September 1982.

Rate of payment of pension contributions

2. In regulation 49 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973(d), there shall be substituted for the words "7 per cent." and "5 per cent." respectively the words "11 per cent." and "8 per cent."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations increase, as from 1st September 1982, the rate of pension contribution payable by a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, in the case of a man from 1p a week less than 7 per cent. of his pensionable pay to 1p a week less than 11 per cent. of his pensionable pay and in the case of a woman from 1p a week less than 5 per cent. of her pensionable pay to 1p a week less than 8 per cent. of her pensionable pay.

The retrospective effect of these regulations is authorised by Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972.
