Building Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983

The Registrar, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 123(1) of the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a), and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, with the consent of the Department of Economic Development(b), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1983.

Revocation

2. The Building Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982(c) are hereby revoked.

Amendment of fees

- 3. The Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(d) shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) in regulation 3, for paragraph (1) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:
 - "(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph 7 of Schedule 2 the fees set out in Schedule 2 shall be payable in advance to the Registrar."
 - (b) for Schedule 2(e) there shall be substituted the following Schedule:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations.)

These regulations prescribe a new structure of fees in connection with transfers of engagements and unions of building societies. The new fees will apply from 1st July 1983, save that where societies have already paid some of the fees for a proposed merger before that date, the old fees will still apply for the registration of that merger.

These regulations also increase by approximately 10% the other fees payable in connection with the exercise by the Registrar of his functions under the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967. They supersede the Building Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982.
