NURSES, MIDWIVES AND HEALTH VISITORS**Local Training Committees of the National Board Order
(Northern Ireland) 1983**

Made 18th May 1983

Coming into operation 1st July 1983

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979(a) as adapted by Schedule 6 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf after consultation with the Central Council hereby makes the following order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Local Training Committees of the National Board Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1983.

(2) In this order unless the context otherwise requires

“The Act” means the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979.

“The National Board” means the National Board for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting for Northern Ireland.

“Central Council” means the United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting.

Constitution of Local Training Committees

2.—(1) For each of the Colleges of Nursing and Midwifery listed in the Schedule there shall be constituted a Committee which shall be known as the Training Committee for that College.

(2) Each Committee shall consist of 14 members appointed by the National Board.

(3) Persons who are not members of the National Board may be appointed as members of the Committee.

(4) The members of each Committee shall include—

(a) the Director of the College;

(b) three persons with experience in the teaching of nurses, midwives or health visitors;

(c) two persons with experience in general education;

(d) two persons with experience in senior nursing management;

(e) three nurses, midwives or health visitors from hospitals or other areas providing facilities for the College;

(f) one person other than a nurse, midwife or health visitor with experience in health service administration;

(g) one person other than a nurse, midwife or health visitor who is a member of the Health and Social Services Board in whose area the College of Nursing is situated or in the case of the Northern Ireland College of Midwifery one person other than a nurse, midwife or health visitor who is a member of a Health and Social Services Board;

(h) one person to be appointed at the discretion of the National Board.

(5) The National Board shall appoint a member of the Committee to be Chairman of the Committee.

Functions of the Training Committees

3. The Training Committees shall assist the National Board in carrying out its training functions set out in section 6(1)(a) to (c) of the Act and they shall discharge the training functions to such extent as the National Board may direct. The Training Committees shall carry out their functions in accordance with directions given to them by the National Board.
