ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Traffic Weight Restriction (Largy Bridge, Limavady)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 13th June 1983

Coming into operation 18th July 1983

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the length of road specified in Article 2 is unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Largy Bridge, Limavady) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 18th July 1983.

Prohibition

2. Vehicles exceeding 2 tonnes in weight whether laden or unladen, are prohibited from using that part of Dogleap Road (DR 236) carried by the Largy Bridge over the river Roe.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles exceeding 2 tonnes laden or unladen weight from using that part of Dogleap Road (DR 236) carried by the Largy Bridge over the river Roe.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
