## ENTERPRISE ZONES

**The Londonderry Enterprise Zones Designation Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1983**

*Made* . . . . . 8th August 1983

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 13th September 1983

Whereas the Department of the Environment (hereinafter referred to as “the Department”) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 4(1) of the Enterprise Zones (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) on 6th May 1983 adopted the Londonderry (Springtown-Pennyburn) and Londonderry (Campsie) Enterprise Zone Planning Schemes;

And whereas in compliance with Article 5(1) and (2) of that Order a notice was published in the Belfast Gazette, the Belfast Telegraph (North-West edition), the Derry Journal and the Londonderry Sentinel relating to the adoption of the Schemes;

And whereas one month has expired since the date of the first publication (namely the publication in the Belfast Telegraph (North-West edition) on 19th May 1983) and no application has been made to the High Court;

Now therefore the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 7(1) and (3) of the Enterprise Zones (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b) hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Londonderry Enterprise Zones Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 13th September 1983.

*Areas designated*

2.—(1) The areas to which the Londonderry (Springtown-Pennyburn) and Londonderry (Campsie) Enterprise Zone Planning Schemes relate and which are shown on the deposited maps and marked accordingly are hereby designated as enterprise zones.

(2) In this Article “the deposited maps” means the set of maps numbered 1 and 2, prepared in duplicate, marked “Maps referred to in the Londonderry Enterprise Zones Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1983” and signed on 8th August 1983 by an Assistant Secretary in the Department, one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the Londonderry Development Office, 19d Limavady Road, Londonderry, and the other duplicate of which has been deposited at the offices of the Department, Parliament Buildings, Stormont.

(3) The boundaries of the enterprise zones are shown on the deposited maps by a black line edged internally with a stippled band but excluding the area hatched and marked “Area to be excluded” on map Number 1. The boundary is represented by the outside of the black line.

*Effective date of designation*

3. The date when the designation takes effect is 13th September 1983.

*Period of designation*

4. The areas are to remain enterprise zones for a period of 10 years from 13th September 1983.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates as enterprise zones the areas of the Londonderry (Springtown-Pennyburn) and Londonderry (Campsie) Enterprise Zone Planning Schemes which were adopted by the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland on 6th May 1983.

The designation is effective for a period of 10 years commencing on 13th September 1983.
