**Electoral Law (Registration Rules) (Variation) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1983**

Made 17th October 1983

Coming into operation 1st December 1983

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State in pursuance of section 28(5) of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(a) hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Electoral Law (Registration Rules) (Variation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1983.

Variation of Registration Rules

2. In rule 26(2) of the Registration Rules in Schedule 3 to the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b)—

- (a) for the words “ten pence” in sub-paragraph (a), there shall be substituted “15p”, and
- (b) for the words “one pound” in sub-paragraph (b), there shall be substituted “£1.50”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases the fees payable under the Registration Rules for copies of parts of the electoral lists or register. In the case of a candidate or his election agent, the fee under rule 26(2)(a) will be 15p for each one thousand names (or part of one thousand) in the lists or register and in the case of any other person the fee under rule 26(2)(b) will be £1.50 for each one thousand names (or part of one thousand).
