Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 22nd November 1983 Coming into operation 21st December 1983

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(5) of the Lands Tribunal and Compensation Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and now vested in me(c) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf. I hereby make the following Order:-

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 21st December 1983.

Revocation

2. The Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(d) is hereby revoked.

Increases in salaries

- 3.—(1) The annual salary payable to the President of the Lands Tribunal shall be increased from 1st August 1983 from £29,000 to £31,250 and from 1st January 1984 from £31,250 to £32,750.
- (2) The annual salary payable to any other member of the Lands Tribunal shall be increased from 1st August 1983 from £27,750 to £29,750 and from 1st January 1984 from £29,750 to £31,000.
