The Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 6) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 30th December 1983 6th April 1984 Coming into operation

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 124(1) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations which correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and which accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980(b) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 6) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1984.
- (2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(c).

Amendment of regulation 87(1) of the principal regulations

- 2. In regulation 87(1) of the principal regulations (modification of section 4(6) of the Act in relation to mariners)—
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for "0.35" there shall be substituted "0.25";
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for "0.6" there shall be substituted "0.5".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 by increasing the percentage rate of primary Class 1 contributions in respect of mariners to whom the provisions of Article 3 of the Redundancy Payments (Merchant Seamen Exclusion) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1973 No. 188) apply, and by increasing the percentage rate of secondary Class 1 contributions in respect of mariners employed on a foreign-going or partly foreign-going ship by reducing the amount by which the secondary contribution is abated.
