The Department of Economic Development(a), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3(2)(b) of the Employment Subsidies Act 1978(b), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(c), hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment Subsidies (Renewal) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1984.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(d), shall apply to this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Renewal

3. The powers of section 1 of the Employment Subsidies Act 1978 shall be renewed for Northern Ireland until the expiration of the period ending on 31st December 1985.

Revocation

4. The Employment Subsidies (Renewal) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(e) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order renews for Northern Ireland until 31st December 1985 the powers of Section 1 of the Employment Subsidies Act 1978, which would otherwise not be exerciseable after 30th June 1984. Section 1 of the Employment Subsidies Act 1978 enables the Department of Economic Development, if it is of the opinion that unemployment in Northern Ireland is continuing at a high level, to set up, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel, schemes for making payments to employers enabling them to retain in employment persons who might otherwise be unemployed, to take on new employees and generally to maintain or enlarge their labour force.

Medicines (Exemption from Licences) (Importation) Order 1984

This Order has been made by the Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 13(2)(3) and 15(1)(2) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act this Order has been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. It is printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1984 and has been numbered 673 in that series.
