The Foyle Fisheries Commission, in exercise of its powers under section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b) with the approval of the Minister for Fisheries and Forestry in the Republic of Ireland and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1984, and shall come into operation on 28th February 1984.
- 2. The Schedule to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976(c) shall be deleted and the following Schedule substituted:—
