Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984

Made 7th September 1984 Coming into operation 12th October 1984

WHEREAS the Department of Economic Development(a) (hereinafter called "the Department) is satisfied that Sean McArdle of 39 Regina Park, Jonesborough, Co. Down, desires to obtain a supply of electricity from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland for his premises at Carrickbroad, Jonesborough, Co. 2. The Department hereby grants permission to the said Sean McArdle to obtain from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland a supply of electricity for his premises at the aforesaid address.
